



• The \_\_\_\_\_ of Prayer

- **Supplications:** To request or plead with God for something. Not necessarily a "form" of prayer as it is an "attitude" in prayer.

***do not be anxious about anything, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God. Philippians 4:6***

- **Prayers** -- Prayer of faith.
- **Intercessions:** To fall in with. It refers to Christians taking the needs of others before the Lord but it goes beyond simply presenting requests to God on the behalf of others.
  - ◇ Involves presenting requests to God on behalf of the needs of others as a mediator, pleading on their behalf.
  - ◇ Speaks of endurance and persistence (Luke 11:5-8; Luke 18:1-5).
  - ◇ A couple scriptures make reference to Christ, our intercessor (Romans 8:34; Hebrews 7:25).
- **Giving Of Thanks:** When we draw near to God in prayer our hearts should be filled with gratitude for all He is all He has done all He is doing and all He will do. Thanksgiving should not be tacked on to the end of our praying but it should be a major ingredient in every prayer we pray.
